RE: Board of Trustee Nominations

The Kent County Public Library is seeking potential nominees for its Board of Trustees to replace the current Trustees effective January 1, 2011.

By Maryland Law, the Board of Trustees consists of seven members appointed by the county governing body (the Kent County Commissioners) from nominees submitted by the Library Board of Trustees. Members are chosen on the basis of character, ability, and demonstrated interest in library matters. Members of the board must be representative of the area the library serves and residents of Kent County. Trustees are appointed for an initial term of five years.

“We are seeking interested Kent County residents to take the reins beginning in January” said Board President, Jack Stenger, “and we are beginning our search immediately in order to provide the Commissioners with a list from which to choose.”
