## REPORT FROM THE BRANCHES

#### **North County**

The North County Branch located in Galena hosted a variety of programs, including weekly preschool storytime, STEM programs for school-age children, the occasional series "Happiness Hour: Creative Time for Grown-Ups," and movies matinees for all ages.


Materials Owned - 41,939 Digital Items - 84,691 Materials Circulated - 139,683 Interlibrary Loan Items Borrowed - 2,544

In August 2017, KCPL entered into the Eastern Shore Library Consortium in order to bring library users more efficient and expansive access to library materials via a consolidated library catalog system that is shared by eight county systems and coordinated by the Eastern Shore Regional Library.

The benefits of streamlined access, faster delivery, and more efficient behindthe-scenes processes resulted in satisfied patrons and a 16% increase in the number of items that were checked out!

### **GRANTS RECEIVED**

### The County Library Capital Grant Program, Maryland State Library

Used for renovations at the Chestertown Branch to install a new HVAC system, redesign the children's department, upgrade the electrical system, and create a combined collaborative/teen space.

Enabled the creation of a Homework Cart at each KCPL location to provide basic supplies for homework and school projects, including Chrome Books that can be borrowed for in-library use.

Provided funding for formal education to two staff members and enabled three staff members to attend the annual Maryland Library Association Conference.

Supported Summer Reading Program activities and events, including the everpopular Summer Reading Game.
