## Quarter 1 (July 1, 2022 - September 30, 2022):

- Faced flat funding challenge from Commissioners, leading to reserve fund utilization.
- Successfully secured \$21,000 from LSTA funds for study pods in North County and Chestertown.

### Quarter 2 (October 1, 2022 - December 31, 2022):

- Received \$27,000 from Kent County Library Foundation to revamp the website.

  Ouarter 3 (January 1, 2023 March 31, 2023):
- Secured \$29,000 from Local Management Board for technology initiatives for local teens.

### Quarter 4 (April 1, 2023 - June 30, 2023):

- Sent entire staff to MLA conference for professional development.
- Completed 85% of FY 23 action items.
- Commissioners granted 6% budget increase, earmarked for staff salaries.
